Dear Students,

The purpose of this communication is to provide you an update on the COVID-19 vaccine requirement. As last communicated on September 17, 2021, the Bon Secours Mercy Health Richmond Market is requiring the COVID-19 vaccine for all students, associates, and providers. Market leadership shared that this decision was based on firm belief, grounded in scientific evidence, that the benefits of the vaccine far outweigh any potential risks. Thank you for your compliance with submitting either your vaccine documentation via Complio and/or the completion of the survey in September.

All students are to have the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine by November 1, 2021 and full vaccination compliance by December 1, 2021. You are required to upload documentation of at least your first dose of the vaccine no later than October 31, 2021. If you are interested in applying for a medical or sincerely held religious exemption then you will need to complete the appropriate form no later than November 1, 2021. (<https://www.schs.edu/covid-19>). A decision about the exemption will be communicated by email to you. If the exemption is granted you will need to upload a copy of the exemption letter to Complio to complete the documentation process.

If you are not granted an exemption and/or you have not completed the vaccination requirement as outlined in the paragraph above, you will not be able to complete your clinical experiences for this semester. Students who are not able to complete their practicum courses will receive a grade of incomplete until practicum requirements are met. In addition, we cannot guarantee that an exemption granted by Bon Secours Southside College of Health Sciences will comply with requirements for practicum in other facilities. Each facility selected for practicum has the right and privilege to require standards for student compliance for experiences in their facility.
