IV. Definitions

Credit/Credit Hour: The number of credits awarded for a given course is determined by the number of lecture, lab, and/or clinical hours spent in class.

V. Policy Details

Student academic classification is based on the number of credit hours completed including transferred hours. Classification is as follows:

Classification	Credits
Freshman	0 – 29
Sophomore	30 – 59
Junior	60 – 89
Senior	90 or above

Enrollment Status	Credits
Full-time	12 or above
Three-quarters time	9 - 11
Half- time	6 – 8
Less than half-time	1 - 5

Credit/Credit Hour Formula:

The following formula is used to calculate credit hours: One semester credit is equal to:

One hour of lecture per week for a semester or the equivalent number of hours. Two hours of lab per week for a semester or the equivalent number of hours. Three hours of clinical per week for a semester or the equivalent number of hours.
