
PRN JOBS ARE STRONGLY RECOMMENDED FOR STUDENTS AND ARE DESIGNATED IN THE JOB TITLE.

APPLY TO JOBS

Click on a specific job. Complete the entire application, attaching your resume as a PDF document If you get an immediate email indicating you will not be advancing in the hiring process, it is likely due to high applicant volumes. Don't be discouraged...just continue to apply. If 10 business days pass without being contacted by anyone in Talent Acquisition (the recruiters), send an email to your Career Advisor who can follow up. (Be sure you've checked voice mail and email.)

If you are invited to interview, check out the resources under Career Services on your school's website for examples of the most common interview questions our students are asked!

ATTEND ORIENTATION

If hired, you will be required to attend New Employee Orientation, unit orientation, a health screening and certain types of training. These are required and must be completed within a certain time frame, but must not interfere with your classes/ clinicals. Check your class schedule and if there is a conflict, ask your manager if there is an on-line module, or you can schedule training on a day you don't have classes/clinicals.

Tips for students utilizing the Guild Benefit

The Bon Secours Mercy Health System offers a tuition incentive if you make two commitments:

- Agree to maintain a modest work schedule while enrolled (PRN: 36 hours over a 6-week period)
- Commit to working for 18 months in any of our hospitals following completion of your studies

By making those two commitments: Nursing students can receive FULL tuition coverage Imaging students can receive a STANDARD tuition discount (\$5,250 each calendar year)
